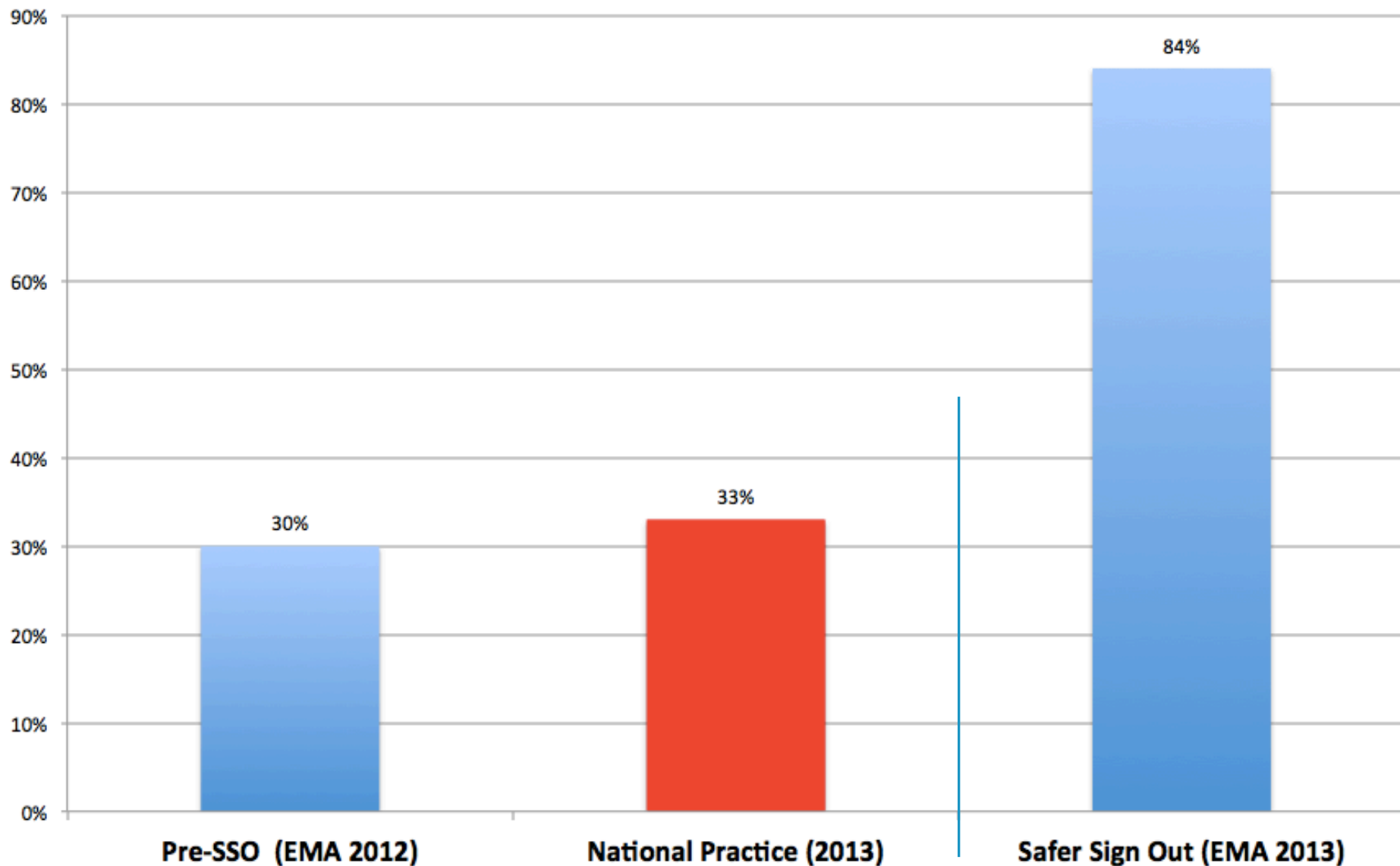

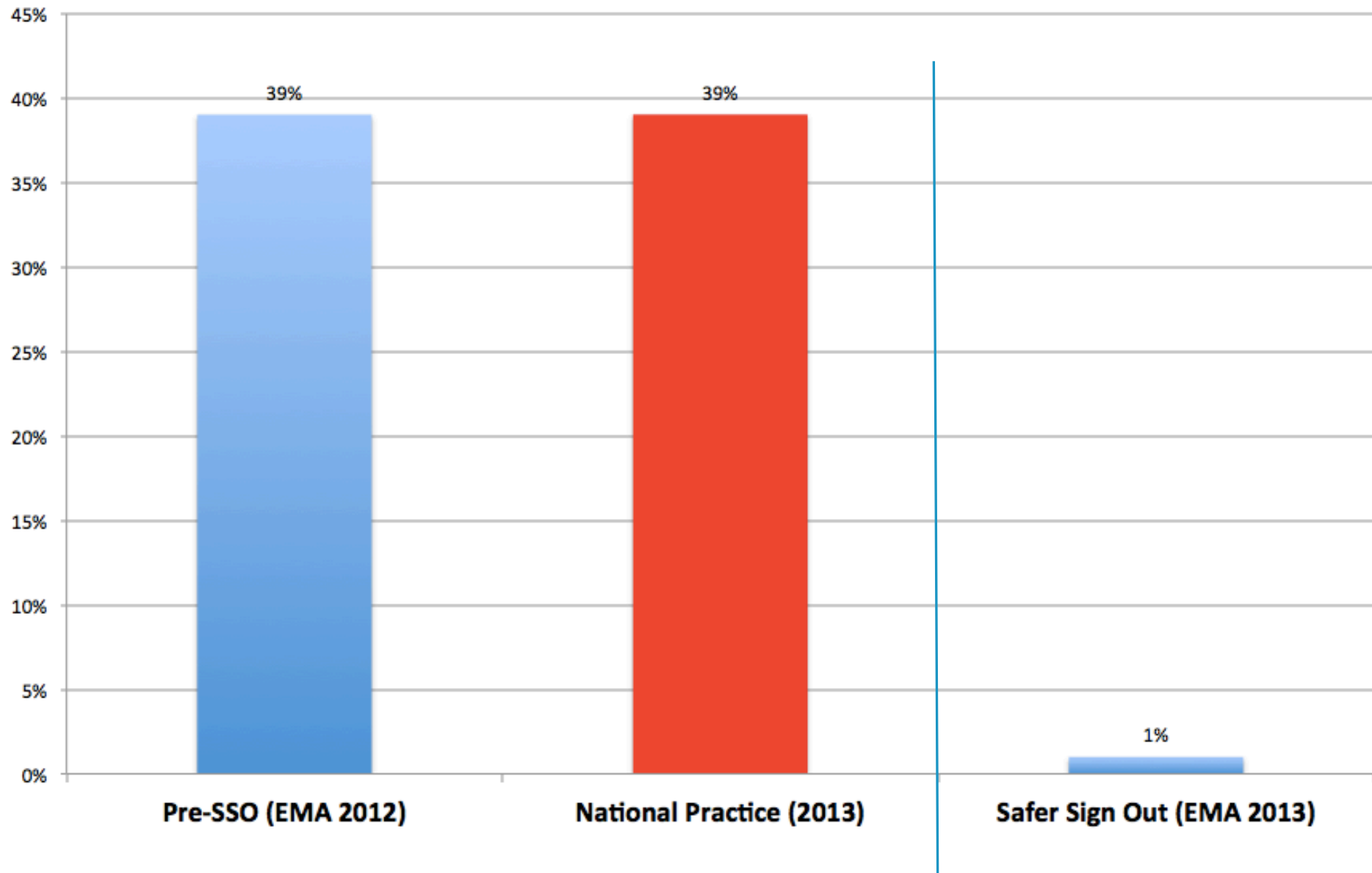
Over 500 Responses (Total)

- * 115 EMA “Safer Sign Out” Responses

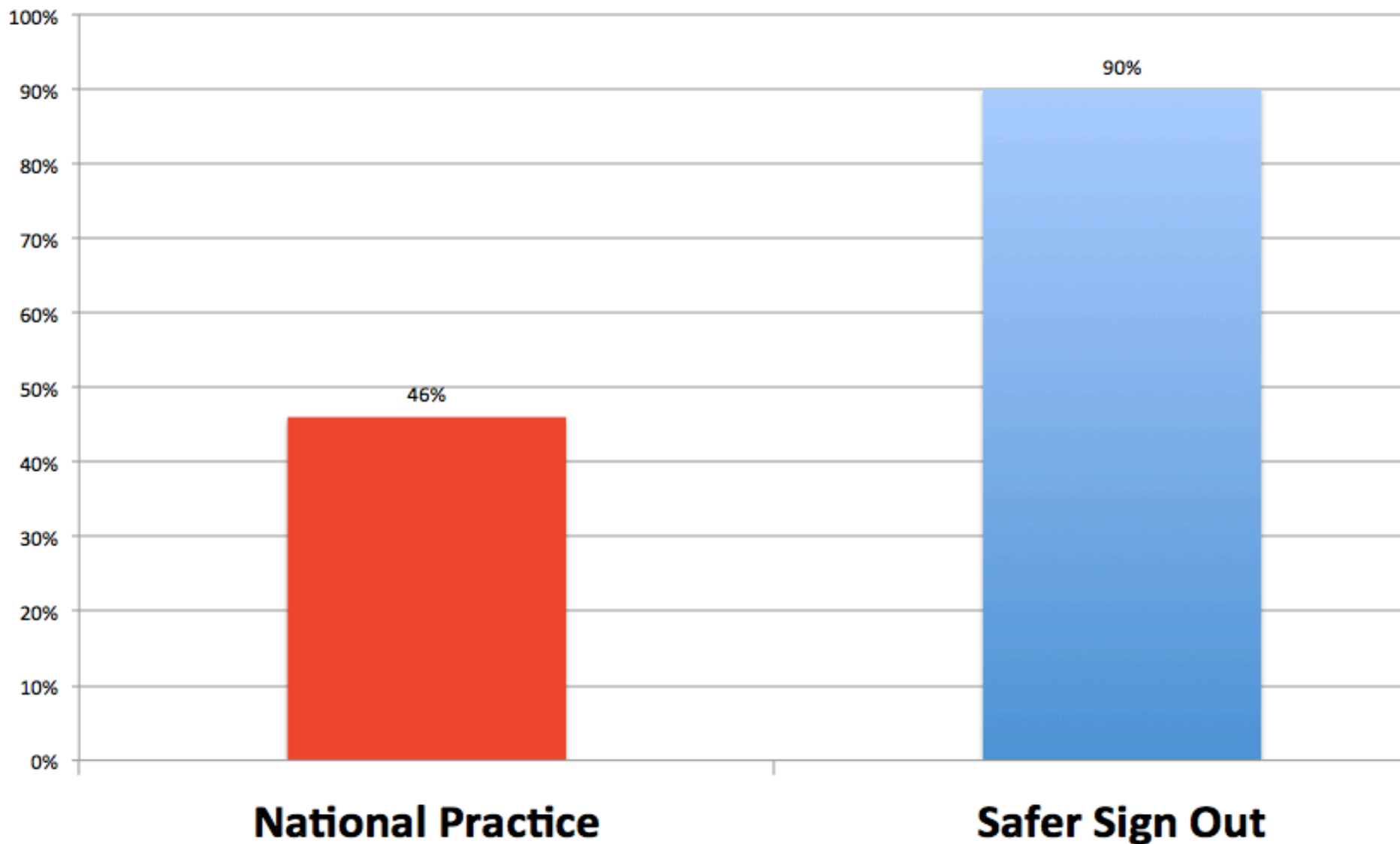
Higher Safety Score (8-10)



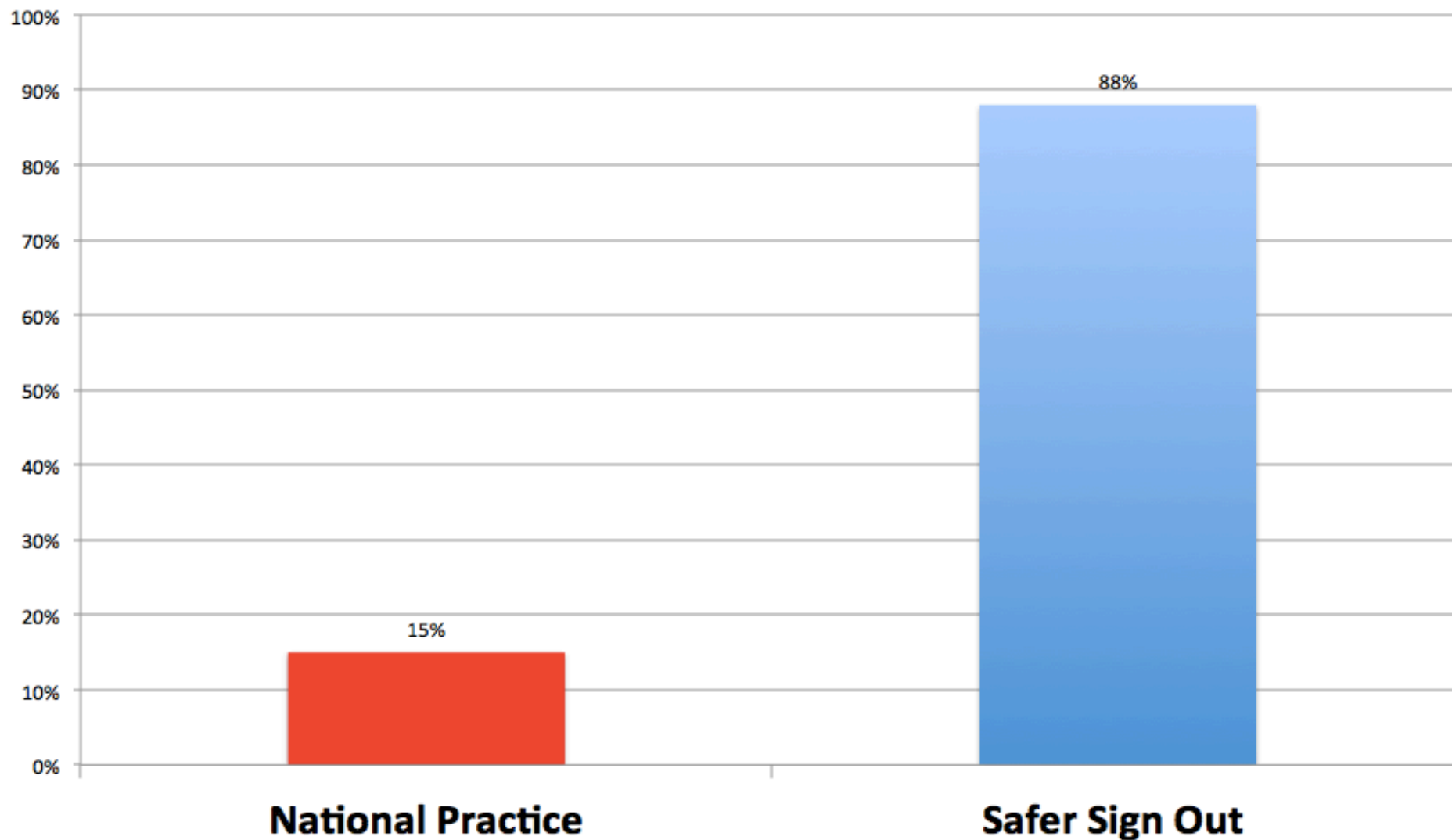
Low Safety Score (1-5)



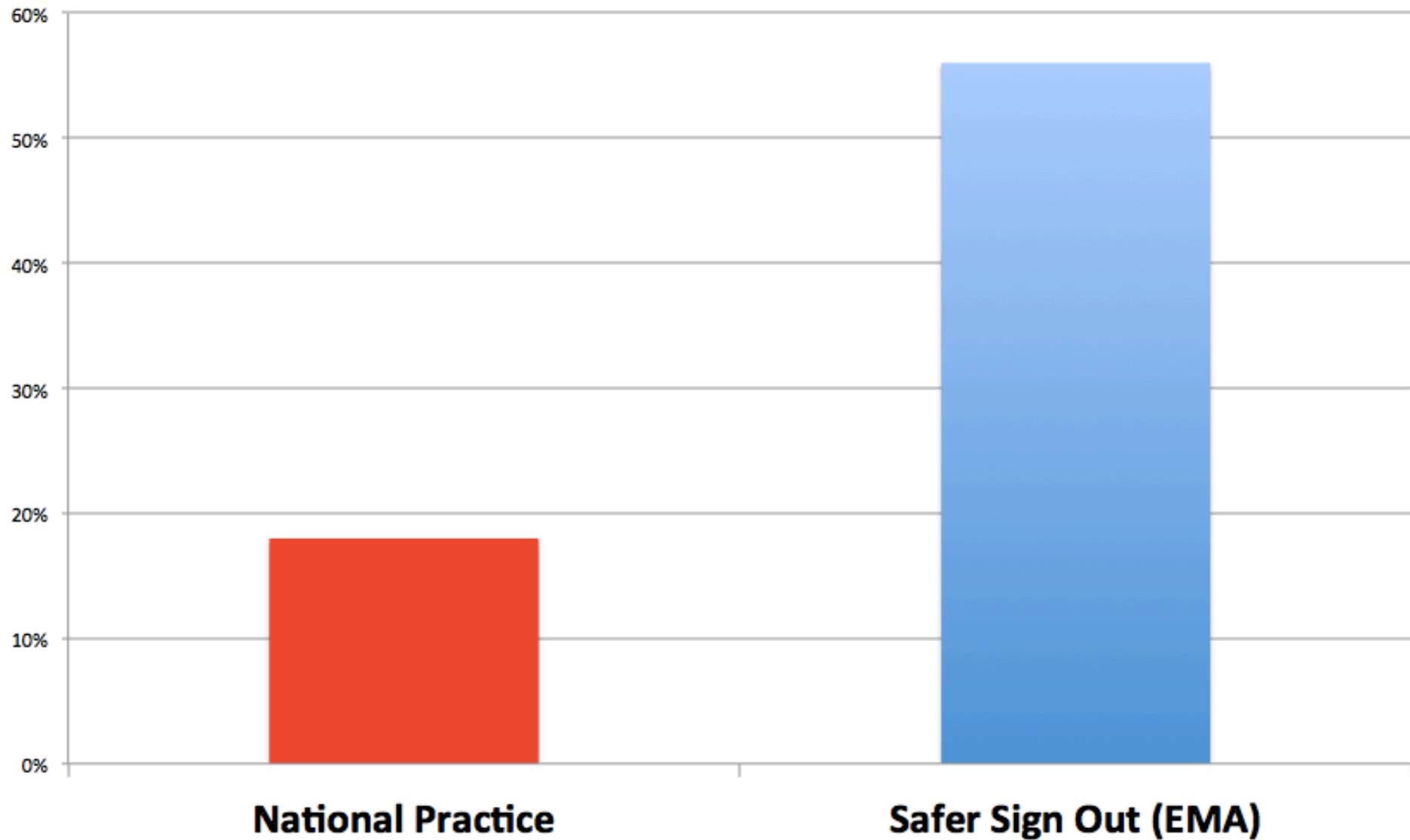
Physician Satisfaction

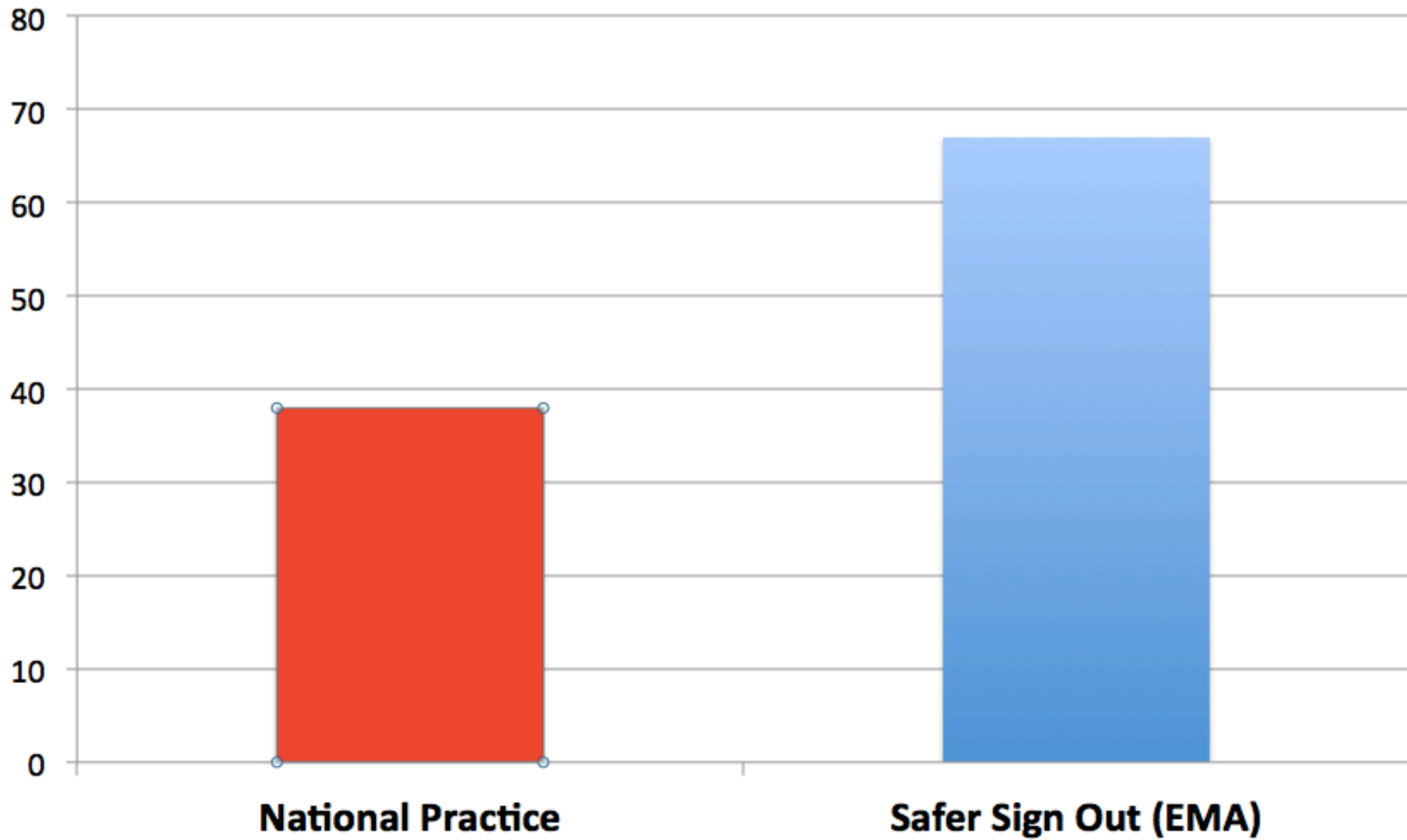
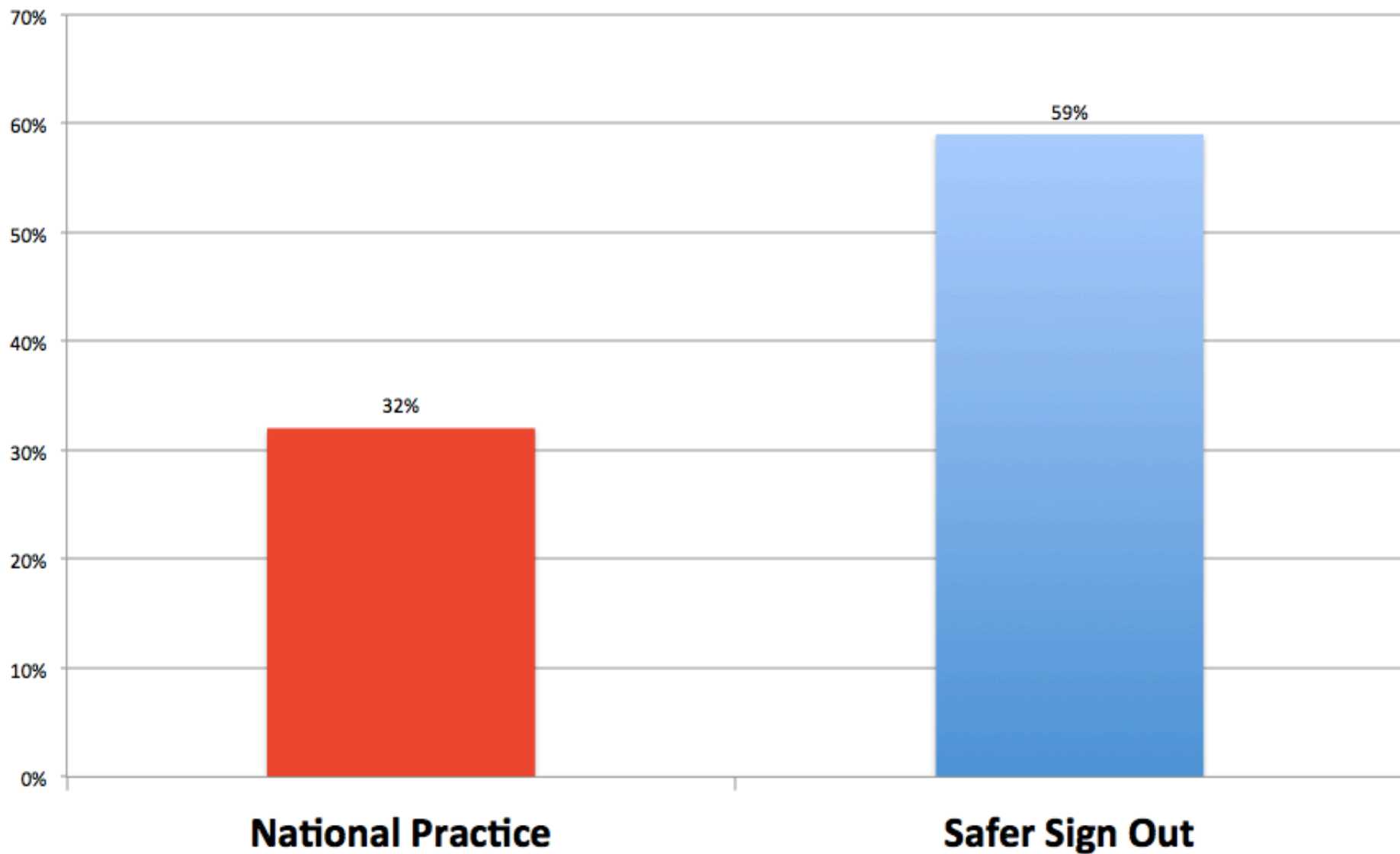
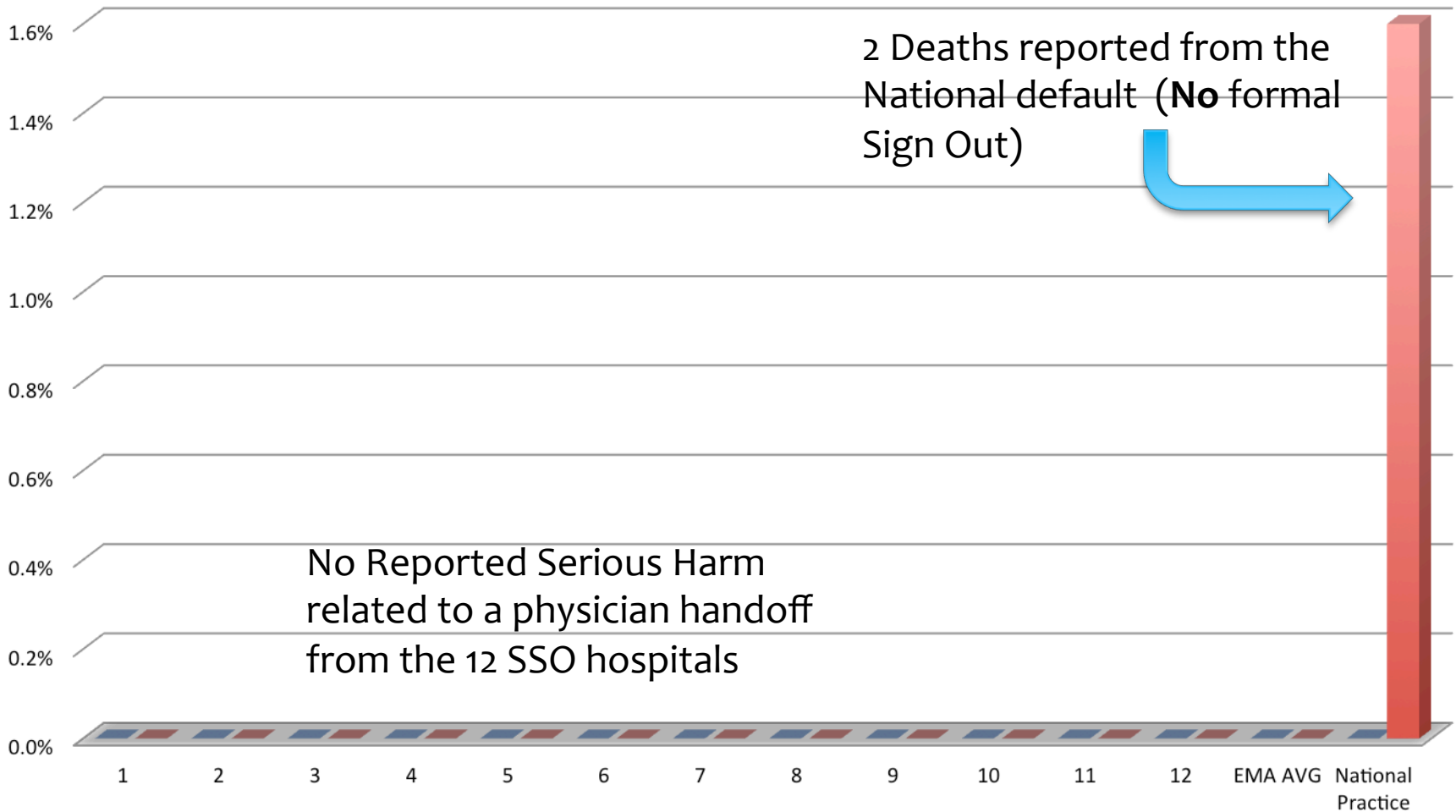


Chart Area

Delays Avoided

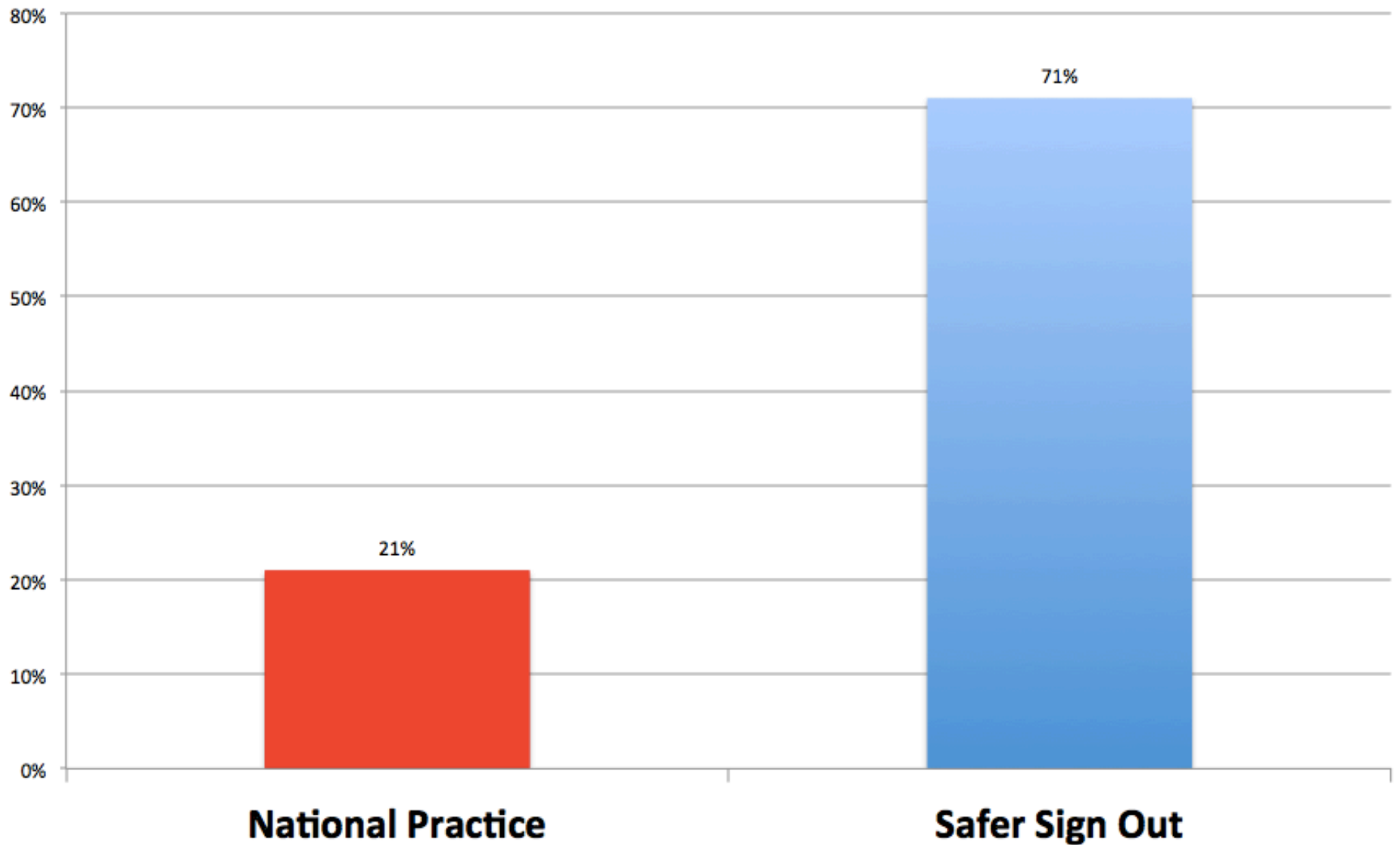


Reported Witnessed Serious Harm

Safer Sign Out Highlights

- * Higher **Safety** Scores
- * Higher Physician **Satisfaction**
- * Higher perceived Information Exchanged
- * Lower Reported Serious Harm
- * Better **Patient Communication**
- * Better **Nurse/Team Communication**
- * Lower perceived **Delays** in Care
- * Lower perceived rate of **Lapses** in Care
